Understanding Act 129 and its Financial Benefits

## **SAVING ENERGY PAYS!**

Allegheny Power will provide information regarding its Act 129 energy efficiency and conservation programs (EE&C). Act 129 requires electric utilities to reduce electricity consumption by 1 percent by 2011, and by 3 percent by 2013. Many of these programs include rebates from the electric utility to encourage energy efficiency measures. These programs are designed for commercial, industrial, government and non-profit customers to increase energy efficiency and conservation.

In general, the EE&C plans for business, government and non-profit customers include:

- ⇒ Financial incentives for energy audits, commercial HVAC upgrades, and efficient equipment purchases
- ⇒ Rebates for high efficiency appliances, lighting and heating and cooling systems
- ⇒ Direct load control programs
- ⇒ Incentives for the installation of variable speed drives
- ⇒ Incentives for reducing kw demand by on-site generation during peak load hours
